What's up in worship?

Today: Taking a cue from last week's message about sharing the Gospel, we'll solidify why sharing the Gospel is so important; that is, it is a response to the Gospel that offers the invitation to be part of the Body/Christ. Belonging is indicated by the presence of Christ through the Holy Spirit in the believer. It may be a bit of a tough sell, perhaps hard to hear, but belonging in itself has to have some parameters, or else it's not "belonging" at all.

Next Week: September 9, 2018: Back to Church Sunday; blended worship followed by lunch: Even as this popular scripture makes its rounds one more time, our focus is not so much on the Body aspect, but rather on the Baptism aspect of being the one Body of Christ. The reason why we belong to each other and why guests are continually invited to belong is not because of what we do, but what Jesus has done. And what or who Jesus has included we cannot exclude. Yet, we are invited into a life of discipleship (growth away from sin) suffering and rejoicing together.
